

CALCIUM HYDROXIDE PASTE

ALL PURPOSE CALCIUM HYDROXIDE PASTE

Description : Ready to use radiopaque, pre-mixed, calcium hydroxide paste with pH above 12.5. Radiopaque Calcium Hydroxide Paste is a creamy paste used for temporary root canal disinfection. Radiopaque Calcium Hydroxide Paste is water soluble, directly dissolves in water. Owing to its high alkalinity (pH 12.5). Calcium Hydroxide neutralize the free acids of the obturating cements and of the restorative materials reduces the hypersensitivity of the dentine and helps the neoformation of secondary dentin.

Composition : Paste contains Calcium Hydroxide, Zirconia, purified water, glycine, polyethylene glycol and other supplementary agents.

Indications: temporary root canal disinfection.

Side effects: There are no known side effects to date.

Application: Temporary disinfectant dressing

Radiopaque Calcium Hydroxide Paste is used as a temporary disinfectant dressing, it is introduced directly into the prepared and dry root canal with the enclosed application tip or a lentulo spiral to ensure that paste reaches the root tip. Application may be repeated, if necessary. Use temporary sealing materials to tightly seal the shape of the open pulp hole to prevent the pollution of the root canal system for 14 days. Tight sealing of the endodontic cavity using temporary filling material is essential in order to avoid the contamination of the root canal system which can occur between appointments.

Removal of Radiopaque Calcium Hydroxide Paste with water. Radiopaque Calcium Hydroxide Paste is water soluble, directly dissolves in water.

The Radiopaque Calcium Hydroxide Paste needs to be removed before final obturation.

Warnings : Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin (allergic contact dermatitis), and eyes. Avoid prolonged inhalation. Do not take internally. Contact with the skin may cause irritation, burns of hypersensitivity. If contact with skin occurs immediately wipe off thoroughly with cotton and alcohol and then wash well with soap and water. If skin rash and sensitization or other allergic reaction occurs discontinue the use and seek medical attention. If the product comes into contact with the eyes, rinse thoroughly with fresh water and consult a physician. It should not be used with patients who have a history of severe allergic reaction to any of the components.

Storage Conditions Radiopaque Calcium Hydroxide Paste has to be stored at 15-30°C / 59-86°F. Do not use Radiopaque Calcium Hydroxide Paste after the indicated date of expiration. After dispensing the material, remove the application tip from the syringe and re-seal the syringe with the original cap.

Expiry date: See note on syringe and packaging. Keep out of the reach of children!

Shelf Life: 3 years from the date of manufacturing.
